

LA VALENTINA

Climate conditions during the winter have been quite steady, with abundant showers and snowfalls. Water reserves were fully replenished from the lows occurred during the warm and dry 2017 year.

The growing season started under favorable climate settings. More challenging conditions followed during spring until the first half of July due to frequent showers. A lot of effort has been spent in order to keep the plants in a healthy environment and to maintain a balanced growing cycle.

Harvest of white grapes started slightly later than usual in mid September and the same delay occurred to red varieties.

Overall production proved to be better balanced both in terms of quantities and quality compared with 2017.

We have positive expectations both for white and red wines, with a possibility of slightly reduced production of reserve wines.
